The add-on course is tailored for students and researchers across disciplines and has been specially designed to bring together a bunch of interdisciplinary approaches to gender – both theoretical and practical - under one umbrella, making it an ideal foun dational course for research as well as for prospective careers in public, private and social sectors.

Students will be taken through a gamut of critical and contextual perspectives involving history, popular culture, literature, photography, film, dance, music, law, health, science, social media, fieldwork, methodologies and theories. Instead of one-way lectures, the sessions will involve audio-visuals, performance demonstrations and PowerPoint presentations and encourage interactive participation through debates and discussions.

Acclaimed resource persons, artists, performers and professional experts from Tufts, Rutgers, DU, WBSU, RBU, CSSS, IACS, Tata Medical Centre, Breakthrough India and other institutions will be teaching and interacting with students as part of this add-on course. In addition, enrolled students will get access to related resources and reading materials. All participants will get a certificate at the end of the programme.
