3. **Date:** 24.06.2020 (online)

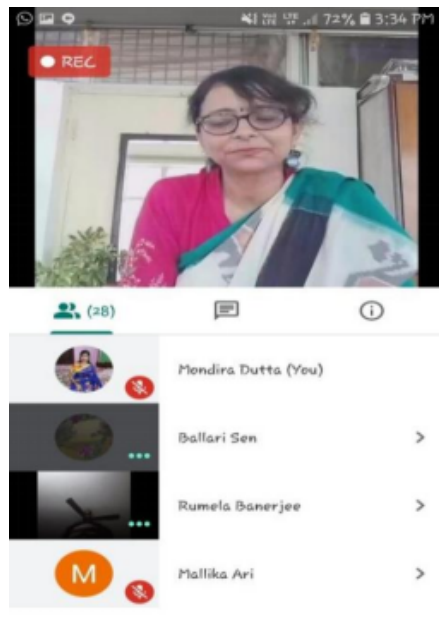
Type of lecture: Extension Lecture online mode

Lecture arranged for: (CBCS System) SEMESTER III & V

Program Outcome: During the tough period of pandemic and lock down this lecture has been arranged to encourage the students to learn the real features of epidemics and pandemics reflected in Bengali literature which not only enhances their knowledge but also helps them to fight the dark period and serve humanity collecting courage, confidence and values from literature. In her discussion she emphasized the change of human values and the effect in subconscious mind which has reflected in the literature. She mentioned the psychological effect in short stories viz. Pyoumukhm, Sarisrip etc. and in a poem of Jibanananda Das.



4. On 16.01.2020 Students were taken to an excursion to Dhanyakuriya and ChandraketuGarh, North 24 Parganas to visit 19th century Bengali Zamindar-familyPalaces, Gothic style architecture, Temples etc.

Outcome of the event: The visit to the palaces of Zamindars and watching the temple architecture helps the students to study the nineteenth century social and cultural history, the milieu of the nineteenth century Bengali literature.
