IQAC ANNUAL REPORT 2021-2022

- 6 meetings of the IQAC were held between July 2021 and 2022.
- RKSMVV currently offers 466 courses across all programmes. The current student strength is 433, and there are 55 full time teachers in the 14 departments, who teach and mentor the students.
- The pass percentage of the 111 outgoing students is 100%.
- 36 students were placed in different service sectors.
- 79 students progressed to higher studies.

- The Quality Enhancement focus of the IQAC this session was on enhancing career opportunities for the students, considering the stagnation of job opportunities at schools and colleges, sectors that are traditionally preferred by women graduates from Humanities and Social Sciences. A total of 583 students benefitted from the career-oriented and coaching courses. The strategies involved were:

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- A large section of students here belong to the economically and socially deprived classes, many of them are first generation learners. There is a system of student support which includes grants, prizes, scholarships and freeships; subsidized hostel accommodation; along with constant mentoring and counseling. During 2021-22, 205 of the 433 enrolled students received government and non-government scholarships, amounting to Rs. 2027980/-; about a 100 students received assistance from the Alumni Association and Student Welfare Committee.
 - A new building – “Nivedita Bhavan” -has been built with RUSA 2.0 funds, which will house classrooms and laboratories.
 - Books and journals, e journals worth Rs. 102176/- were added to the Central Library collection, in addition to the regular software upgradation.
 - 5 faculty members attended 8 Faculty Development Programmes.
