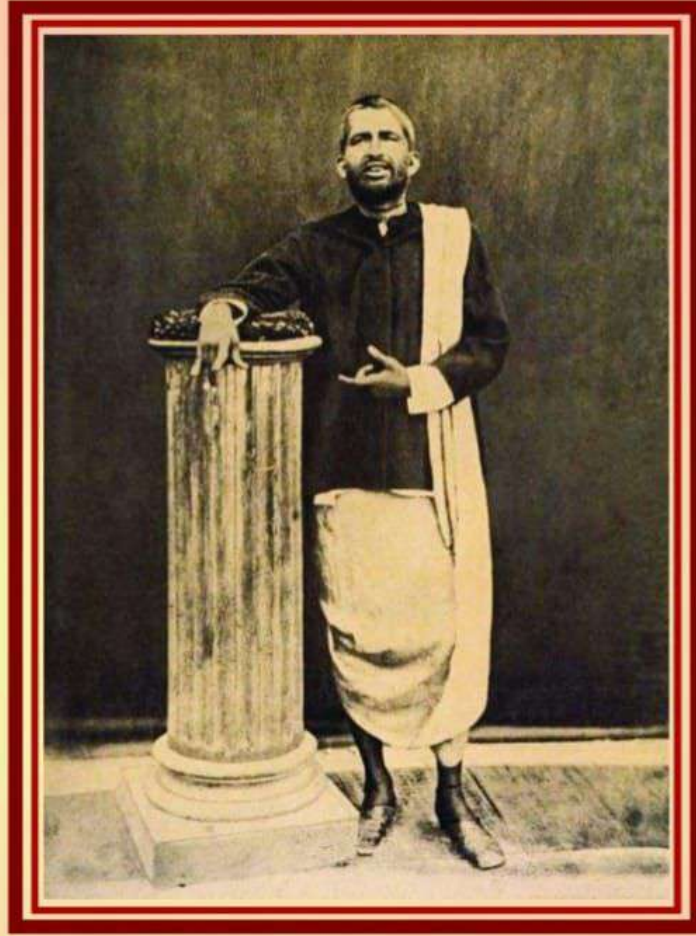

Each paper must include an abstract not exceeding 250 words.
