Emphasis is given on the importance of a network of spies and informers who do function as a surveillance corps for the king. Basically the kings see through the eyes of the spies “rājānaḥcārcakṣuḥ” (Bhāravi’s Kirātārjunīyaṃ1.1). Since times immemorial, man’s curiosity and interest in self-

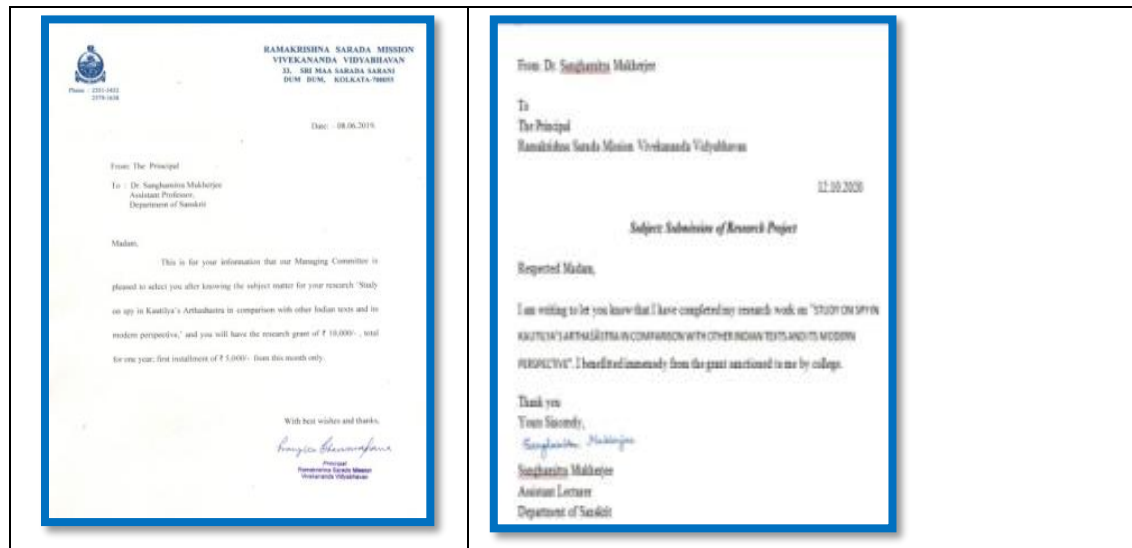
Abstract of the Project: Handloom Industry and Weavers' Status at Begumpur of Hoogly District, West Bengal

Begumpur Handloom Industry of West Bengal plays an important role in the handloom map of West Bengal as well as of India. The present study is aimed to address these reasons through investigation of the socio-economic conditions and problems of the local weavers and analysis of the overall nature, method of production and structure of the regional weaving co-operative society. Both the pre- and post-field studies, including the collection of primary and secondary data from the Chanditala II Community Development Block and different co-operative staffs are carried out to find out the root cause of the problem and to perceive the socio-economic status of the weaving community.

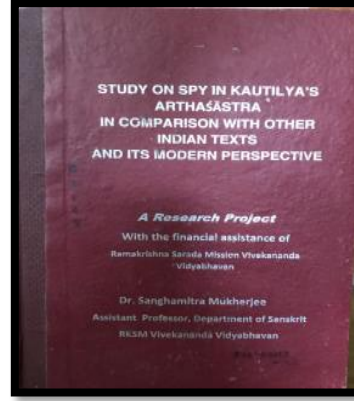

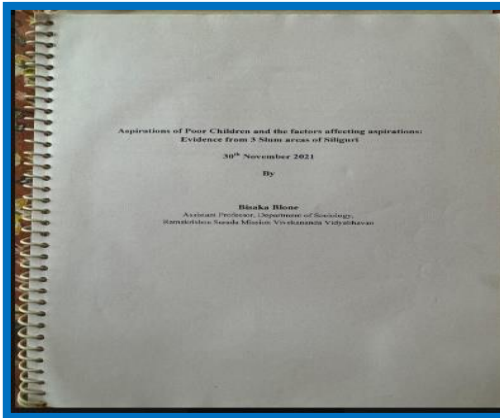

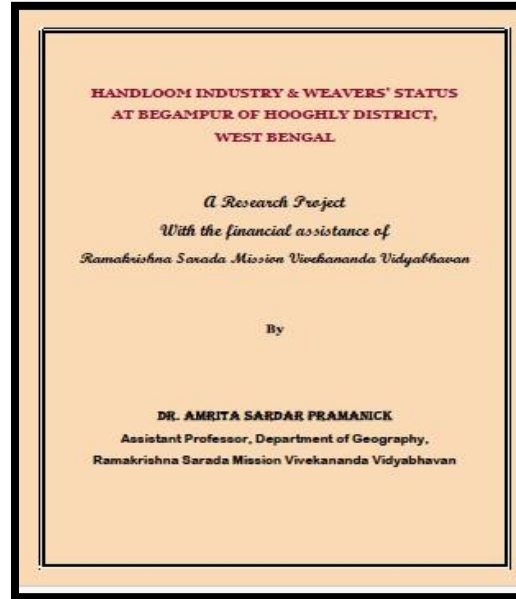

1. **Nibedita Banerjee, Department of Psychology**, December 11, 2020, An EXPERIMENTAL STUDY ON ADOLESCENTS WITH AND WITHOUT SPECIFIC LEARNING DISABILITY.

Abstract: The talk made an in-depth analysis of the philosophy of language, its various usages and how language has undergone shifts in its textual presentations. It then took a post-modernist view of the way language has become an instrument of power relations and the way verbal and written language are differently used to suit specific purposes.

4. **Soma Mukhopadhyay, Department of Geography**, September 8, 2021, IMPROPER URBANIZATION ON INSPIRATIONAL WETLAND OF RAJARHAT AND ADJOINING AREAS, WEST BENGAL ANALYSIS BY GIS

The talk addressed the problem of unplanned urbanization, the drying up of wetlands and how that is affecting environment. The talk used empirical evidences based on interviews and reports by NGOs and other organisations. It also used drone photos of the areas where the problem of drying up of wetlands is most pronounced.

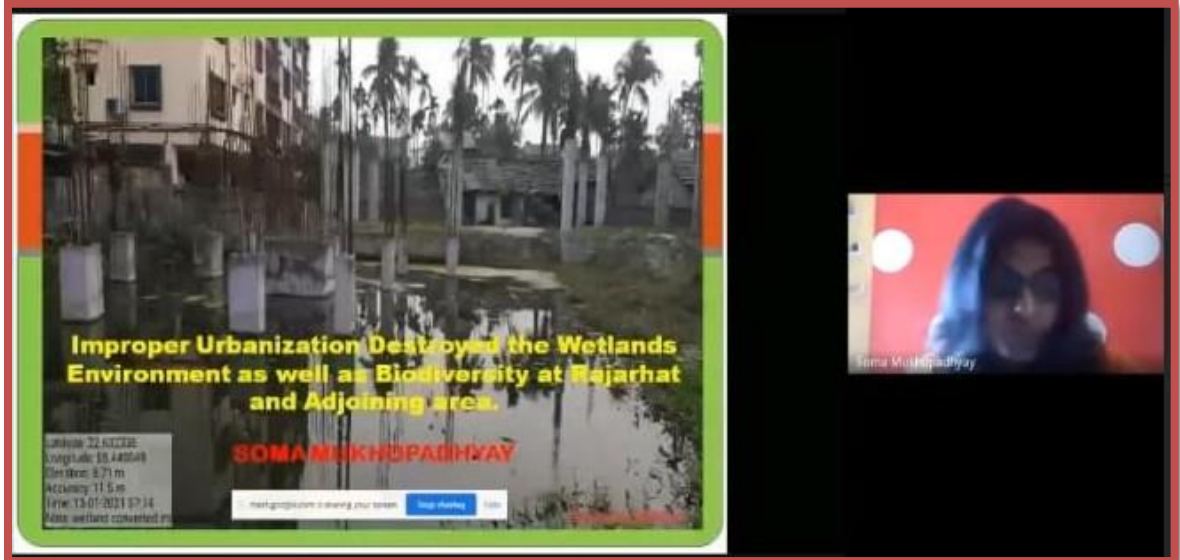

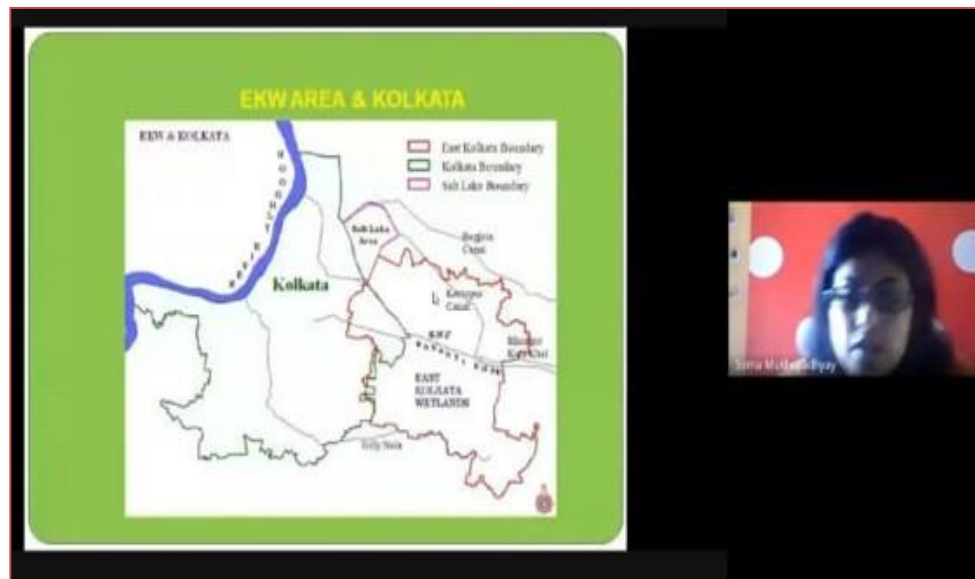
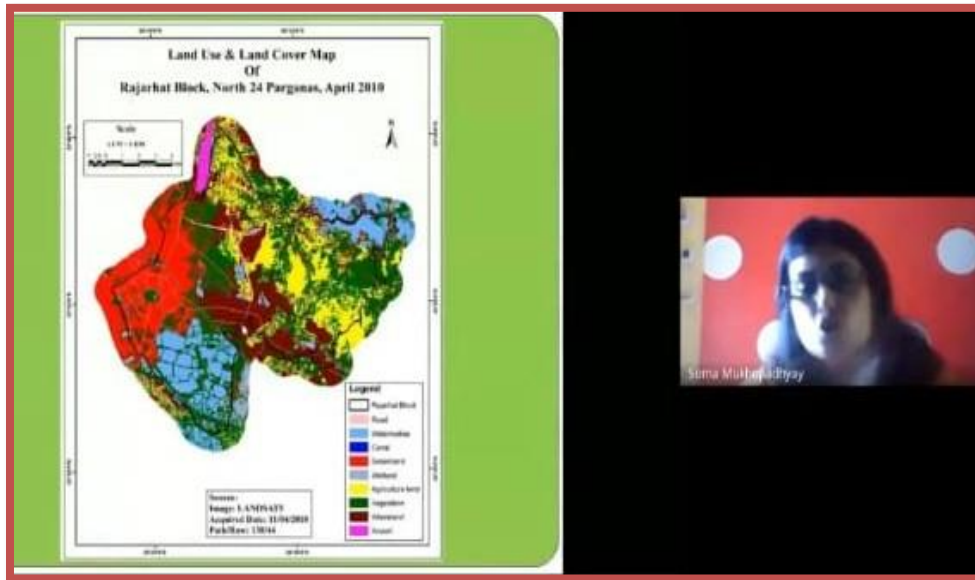
