Brief Description of the Event: The Department of Human Rights in collaboration with IQAC organized an event to celebrate International Day of Democracy through a Poster Presentation by the Students and a Movie Screening regarding “Peace” on 26th September 2024 from 10:15 am to 11:15 am. Students shared their speech on “Peace” through Poster. After completing this session, a movie was conducted and it’s all about a 10-minute Movie which talks about The International Day of Peace, also officially known as World Peace Day, which is a United Nations-sanctioned holiday observed annually on 21 September.
