Brief Description of the Event: International Dance Day is a global celebration of dance promoted by the International Dance Council (CID) and the International Theatre Institute. Dance Day is observed on 29th April, birth anniversary of the famous 18th century dancer Jean-Georges Noverre, who is considered to be the "father" or creator of modern ballet. The purpose of this observance is to raise awareness of dance as an art form, as a means of cultural expression, and as an educational tool.

The members of the Ramakrishna Sarada Mission Vivekananda Vidyabhavan Srijoni Dance Club prepared a short performance to observe this special day. They celebrated the spirit of life in their portrayal of various folk dance forms which are manifestations of various aspects of every day life, especially of the agrarian community.
