Brief Description of the Event: Research Methodology is an essential part of Education as a whole. Students wishing to pursue either research or Doctoral research, need to know the basic information and idea of research methodology. So the Departments of Education and Political Science organized a workshop on Research Methodology in collaboration with IQAC. The workshop was organized to enhance the research capabilities of participants by equipping them with the knowledge of necessary tools, techniques, and understanding of research processes.

It was a 3-day workshop (28th, 30th and 31st of May, 2025). The workshop was arranged in three parts. The workshop included lectures on basics of research (1st day), discussion on survey method (2nd day) and a follow up session (3rd day) along with Q&A sessions.

Both the speakers delivered the complex topics so interestingly that the students enjoyed it. The students gained a comprehensive understanding of different research approaches. The lecture on survey method enhanced participants' understanding of survey design, data collection, and analysis techniques in social science research. The workshop on survey method equipped

students with practical tools for conducting empirical research effectively. The students got to know about different types of survey methods, the process of designing effective questionnaires, data collection tools, ethical considerations in survey research, techniques for analyzing survey data and so on. The participants also had a follow-up session on the final day.

Outcome of the Event: Participants gained practical insights into developing and conducting research. They also gained a clear understanding of how to plan and execute a survey. The feedback was overwhelmingly positive. The workshop on Research Methodology was a successful academic initiative that significantly benefitted the students.
