Programme Outcome:

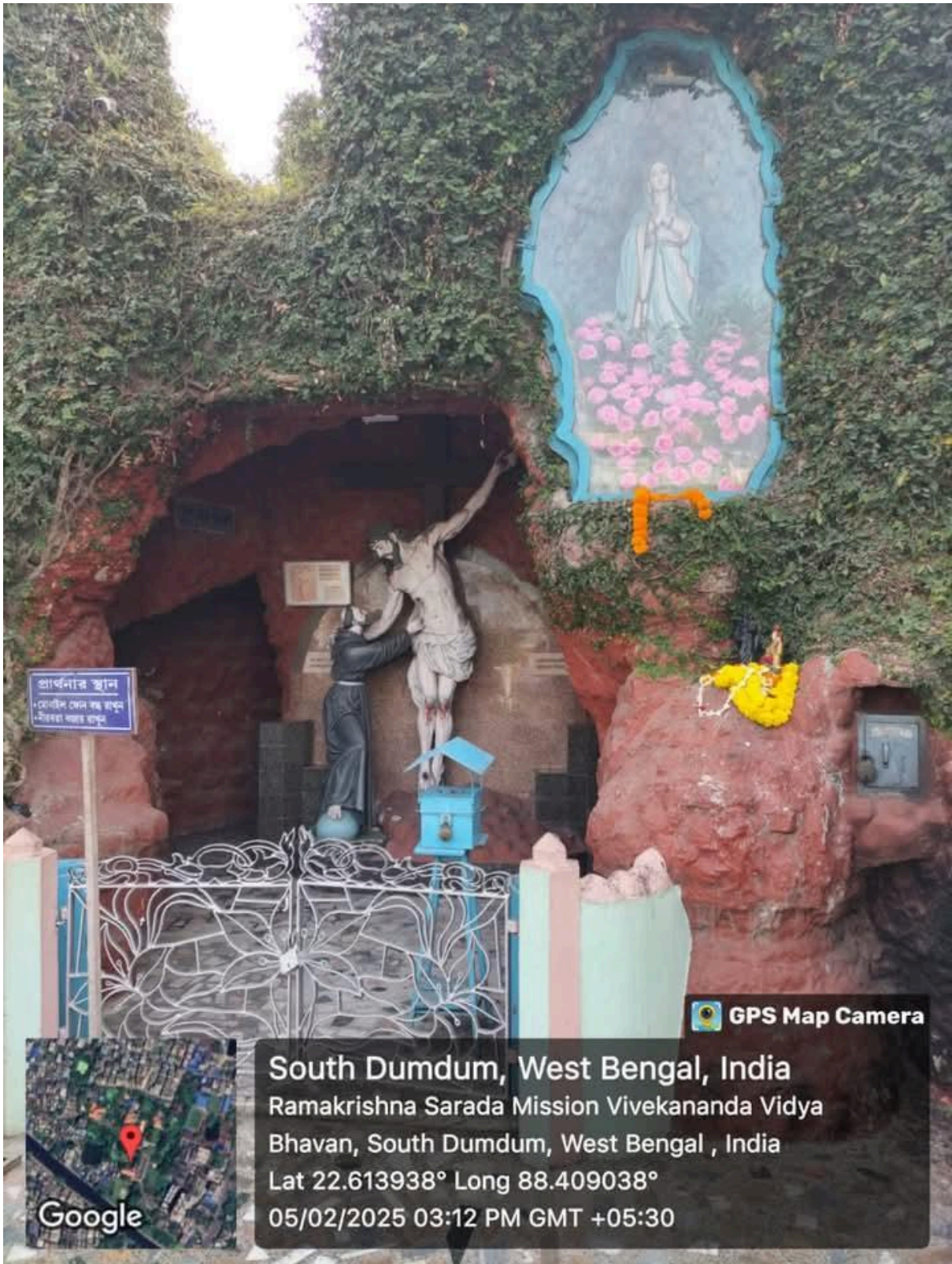
