**Brief Description of the Event:** The Orientation Programme for Semester IV students was organized by the Placement Cell and IQAC of Ramakrishna Sarada Mission Vivekananda Vidyabhavan on 6th August, 2025, at 2:45 PM in Room No. 25. The event aimed to introduce students to the objectives and importance of the Placement Cell and guide them toward career readiness.

Convenor Sreejaya Chatterjee initiated the session by explaining the significance and purpose of the Placement Cell, emphasizing its role in career-building and skill development.


A presentation was delivered by Dr. Rakhi Ghosh, highlighting the key achievements and initiatives of the Placement Cell to inspire students and make them aware of available opportunities. Sreejaya Chatterjee and Tanika Deb Roy provided a detailed walkthrough of a Google Form that the students were required to fill out for their career orientation and placement-related preferences. A total of 99 students from Semester IV attended the programme, and all of them participated actively throughout the session. Their queries during the interactive segments reflected their enthusiasm and eagerness to explore placement opportunities.

The explanation and submission of the Google Form ensured that the Placement Cell could collect structured data on the students' career interests, preferred sectors, and training needs. This will help in customizing future workshops, training programs, and placement drives. The motivational talk helped instill confidence and a sense of purpose. The practical suggestions and real-life examples shared during the session left a strong impact.
