Brief Description of the Event : The Mega Job Fair & Campus Interview was organized by the Placement Cell and IQAC of Ramakrishna Sarada Mission Vivekananda Vidyabhavan (RKSMVV) in collaboration with the JIS Foundation. The event aimed to provide students with direct employment opportunities and exposure to real industry recruitment processes. Before the job fair, the JIS Foundation conducted a four-month free training programme designed to enhance students' communication skills, professional behaviour, interview preparation, and overall job readiness. This initiative ensured that trained students were well-prepared and confident while facing recruiters on the day of the interview.

The job fair brought together several reputed companies from different sectors, creating a multi-industry platform for aspiring candidates. Both trained and non-trained students were

allowed to participate, ensuring inclusiveness and providing equal opportunities for all job seekers. A total of 281 candidates applied for the event, out of which 193 appeared, representing a diverse mix of participants from RKSMVV and other institutions.

During the event, company representatives conducted different stages of the selection process, including preliminary screening, HR interaction, and job role discussions. Students had the opportunity to interact with recruiters, understand job requirements, and showcase their skills. The event created a professional environment on campus and helped students gain valuable exposure to corporate expectations. The Mega Job Fair successfully bridged the gap between academic learning and industry requirements. It offered a platform not only for employment but also for learning, networking, and enhancing career aspirations. Overall, the event was a significant step toward empowering students with practical employment opportunities and strengthening the placement initiatives of the institution.

Programme Outcome : The Mega Job Fair & Campus Interview organized at RKSMVV proved to be a highly impactful initiative aimed at enhancing students' employability and providing them with direct access to industry opportunities. One of the significant outcomes of the programme was the successful collaboration between the institution and the JIS Foundation, which not only brought multiple reputed companies to the campus but also facilitated a four-month free JIS training course. This training programme helped many students develop essential industry-oriented skills, improve their communication abilities, and gain confidence for real interview situations. As a result, trained students were better prepared and performed well during the recruitment process.

The event also created equal opportunities for both trained and non-trained candidates, ensuring inclusiveness and wide participation. With 281 applications and 193 students appearing for interviews, the job fair attracted a diverse pool of aspirants from RKSMVV and various other institutions. This contributed to a vibrant recruitment environment where candidates could interact with HR professionals, understand industry expectations, and explore multiple career options in one platform.

Another important outcome was the strengthening of industry–academia linkage. Participating companies such as Mervice Infotech, Maxicus, Globiva Services, and others provided insights into current market trends, required skills, and emerging job roles. Students gained first-hand exposure to professional recruitment procedures, such as aptitude tests, group discussions, and personal interviews. This experience helped them understand the importance of skill development, professionalism, and continuous learning in today's competitive job market.

Overall, the Mega Job Fair served as a career-enhancing platform that boosted students' employability, supported their career aspirations, and reinforced the institution's commitment to providing holistic career guidance. The programme encouraged students to prepare better for future placements and built a strong foundation for their professional growth.
