- **Brief description of the event :**
The AIDS Awareness Programme was successfully organized by the NSS Team of RKSMVV on 02 December 2025 with the objective of creating awareness about HIV/AIDS, its prevention, treatment, and the importance of eliminating stigma and discrimination. The programme aimed to sensitize students and volunteers about responsible behavior, early diagnosis, and the role of youth in spreading correct information in society.

The programme was enriched by the presence of two eminent resource persons. Shri Jagadish Jana, Assistant Director (GIPA), West Bengal State AIDS Prevention & Control Society, Department of Health & Family Welfare, Government of West Bengal, delivered an informative session highlighting the current status of HIV/AIDS, government initiatives, preventive strategies, and community participation under GIPA to combat the disease.

The second session was conducted by Ms. Sanghita Mukherjee, Counsellor, R.G. Kar Medical College & Hospital, Kolkata, who sensitively addressed the psychosocial aspects of HIV/AIDS. She emphasized counseling, mental health support, myths and misconceptions, and the importance of empathy and inclusivity towards people living with HIV/AIDS.

The programme witnessed active participation from NSS volunteers and students, making it an effective platform for learning, interaction, and awareness-building. The event concluded with a strong message of awareness, compassion, and collective responsibility in the fight against HIV/AIDS.

- **Student Engagement and Leadership :** NSS volunteers actively participated in organizing and conducting the programme, enhancing their leadership skills, teamwork, and sense of social service.
- **Community Sensitization :** The programme contributed to spreading awareness beyond the campus by motivating participants to act as peer educators within their communities.
- **Alignment with National Health Goals :** The programme supported national initiatives aimed at HIV/AIDS prevention and health awareness, reinforcing the role of educational institutions in public health advocacy.
