Description of the Event:

The Recitation Competition (Bengali, English, and Sanskrit), organized by the Cultural Sub Committee of RKSMVV on 10th December 2025, was a celebration of linguistic diversity, literary heritage, and expressive performance. Conducted simultaneously in three different venues, the event provided students with a vibrant platform to showcase their oratory skills and interpretative abilities across three rich literary traditions.

In the Bengali Recitation, participants presented poems reflecting the depth and diversity of Bengali literature. The selected poem for recitation was “Jagbar Din Aaj” by Sukanta Bhattacharya. Through expressive modulation, clear diction, and emotional depth, students brought the lyrical beauty of the Bengali language to life, paying tribute to Bengal’s rich cultural and literary legacy.

The Sanskrit Recitation segment aimed to revive interest in India’s classical language and its timeless literary traditions. The selected poem for recitation included verses from “Geetgovindam” by Jayadev. Students recited verses from ancient scriptures and classical poetry, emphasizing correct pronunciation, rhythm, and clarity. The serene and scholarly ambience highlighted the musicality and precision of Sanskrit, fostering respect for its foundational role in Indian intellectual heritage.

The English Recitation competition offered a dynamic engagement with English poetry. The selected poem for recitation was “Freedom to the Slave” by Henry L. V. Derozio. Participants demonstrated a strong command of pronunciation, intonation, and dramatic expression, transforming written texts into compelling oral performances. The event emphasized the connection between literary understanding and performance skills.

Across all three languages, judges assessed participants on pronunciation, clarity, confidence, emotional expression, and overall presentation, making the event both competitive and enriching.

Outcome:

The Recitation Competition significantly enhanced students’ confidence in public speaking and refined their articulation, pronunciation, and expressive abilities. It deepened their appreciation for poetry and literature across Bengali, English, and Sanskrit traditions while encouraging cultural awareness and linguistic pride.
