

The program commenced with a brief introduction highlighting the importance of orientation for newly admitted students. The speakers elaborated on the definition of ragging as per UGC guidelines, types of ragging, and the serious psychological, emotional, and legal consequences associated with it. Emphasis was laid on zero tolerance towards ragging and the responsibility of every student in maintaining discipline and mutual respect on campus.


The members also explained the structure and functioning of the Anti-Ragging Cell, grievance redressal mechanisms, helpline numbers, and the procedure for reporting incidents confidentially. Real-life examples and interactive discussions helped students understand how to

identify and respond to potential ragging situations. The session concluded with an open interaction, where students actively participated by asking questions and clarifying doubts.
