- **Brief description of the event:** The NSS Unit of RKSMVV in collaboration with IQAC and 7 alumni of Ramakrishna Sarada Mission Vivekananda Vidyabhavan successfully organized an outreach programme at S.C. Sen Old Age Home on 7th February 2026. It is the Kestopur Jagorani Foundation's initiative. This old age home is named "NATUN GHAR". It is situated at Muragachha, in between Madhyamgram and Sodepur. A total of 08 female and 12 male old persons are rescued either from Sealdah railway station, or any metro station, or from roads of Shyambazar etc. and are looked after here. NSS volunteers asked their name, whereabouts and from where they came. They entertained those aged persons with recitation and song. The aged people became very delighted and enjoyed those cultural performances. The NSS volunteers provided them sarees and lungis and seasonal fruits, while alumni gave them other necessary things and food items.

- **Programme Outcome:**

Community outreach is a core component of NSS activities, encouraging students to actively participate in social welfare initiatives. This outreach programme is done with the objective of fostering social responsibility and sensitivity, humanitarian values, empathy, and intergenerational bonding among volunteers. They developed a deeper understanding of the emotional, psychological, and social needs of elderly residents through direct interaction and engagement.

Meaningful conversations and cultural performances helped bridge the gap between youth and senior citizens, promoting mutual respect and affection. The presence and involvement of volunteers brought joy and companionship to the elderly inmates, reducing feelings of loneliness and isolation.

Volunteers enhanced their communication skills, leadership qualities, and sense of civic duty through active participation in organizing and executing the programme. It instilled values of compassion, gratitude, and social commitment, aligning with the NSS motto, "Not Me, But You." It not only brought happiness to the elderly residents but also enriched the volunteers with invaluable life lessons.
