**Brief Description of the Event:** To commemorate **International Women’s Day**, the Department of Human Rights in collaboration with the Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) organized a special lecture titled “*Giving Voice to the Unheard*” on 7th March 2026 at Room No. 39 of Ramakrishna Sarada Mission Vivekananda Vidyabhavan College. The lecture was delivered by **Dr. Sheli Dutta**, who spoke on the importance of recognizing and amplifying the voices of marginalized and underrepresented women in society.
