

## **Event Report of Internal Complaints Committee**

**Name of the Activity:** Film Screening on Sexual Harassment

**Number of participants:** 106 students of semester 4 and 145 students of semester 6 – Total students 251

**Brief Description of the Event:** A film was screened on Sexual Harassment for all 251 students of semesters 4 and 6 on the occasion of International Working Women's Day. The screening aimed to raise awareness about the different forms of sexual harassment and their impact on individuals and society.

Following the screening, students were sensitized to issues of consent, dignity, and gender equality. The session also highlighted the importance of reporting mechanisms and informed students about the role of the Internal Complaints Committee (ICC) in addressing such grievances. The programme created a reflective and engaging environment, encouraging students to think critically about their roles in promoting a safe and respectful campus.

**Programme Outcome:** Students gained confidence on how to combat Sexual Harassment. The screening significantly enhanced students' awareness and understanding of sexual harassment, including its various forms, legal implications, and preventive measures. It encouraged open reflection on personal safety, consent, and respectful behavior in academic and social spaces. Students developed greater confidence in identifying inappropriate conduct and learned about the mechanisms available for reporting grievances, particularly the role of the Internal Complaints Committee (ICC).

The programme also fostered a sense of responsibility among students to contribute to a safer and more inclusive campus environment. It empowered them to speak up against injustice, support peers facing such issues, and uphold gender sensitivity in their everyday interactions.
