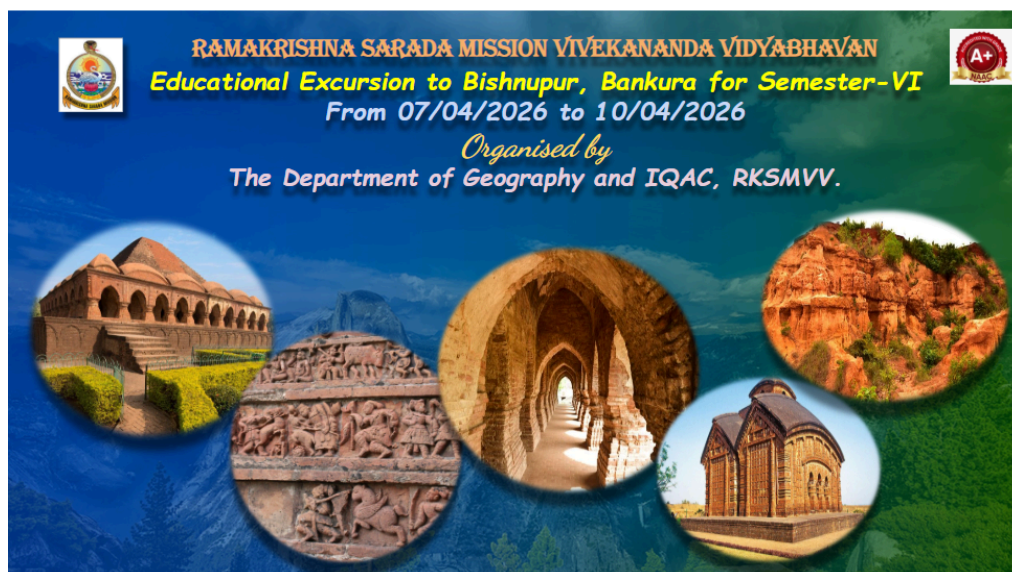


## Field Trip to Chougan mouza of Bishnupur from 07.04.2026 to 10.04.2026

- **Name of the Activity** - Compulsory Educational Field Trip

- **Brief description of the event** - A three-day compulsory educational trip, as a part of the curriculum, was organised by the Department of Geography, RKSMVV for students of Semester-6, from 7th April to 10th April, 2026 for socio-economic study to evaluate the relation between physical and cultural landscape at Chougan mouza of Bishnupur, Bankura, West Bengal.
- **Programme Outcome** - The educational field trip to Bishnupur in Bankura provided students with valuable experiential learning opportunities related to history, culture, geography, and heritage conservation.
  - Students gained firsthand knowledge about the rich cultural and historical heritage of Bishnupur, particularly its famous terracotta temples, traditional art forms, and architectural styles.
  - The field trip strengthened students' observation, note-taking, and documentation skills through direct interaction with physical landscapes, and local communities.
  - Students learned about the physiographic features, natural environment, and settlement patterns of the Chougan mouza through on-site observation.
  - Participation in group travel and collaborative activities improved communication, cooperation, leadership, and time-management skills among students.
  - The trip motivated students to explore local history, culture, and geography and encouraged independent learning.
  - Overall, the field trip contributed to students' intellectual growth, cultural awareness, confidence, and appreciation for India's heritage.

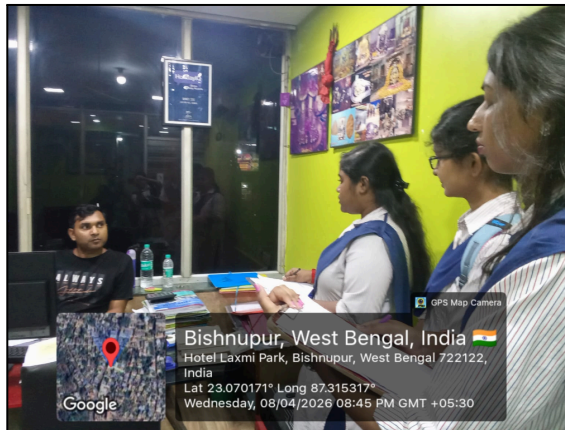




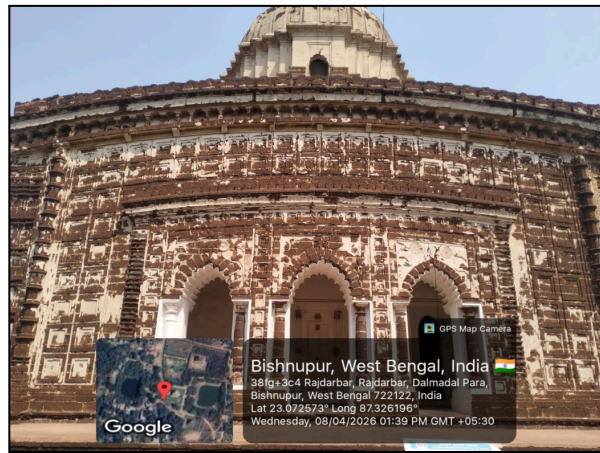

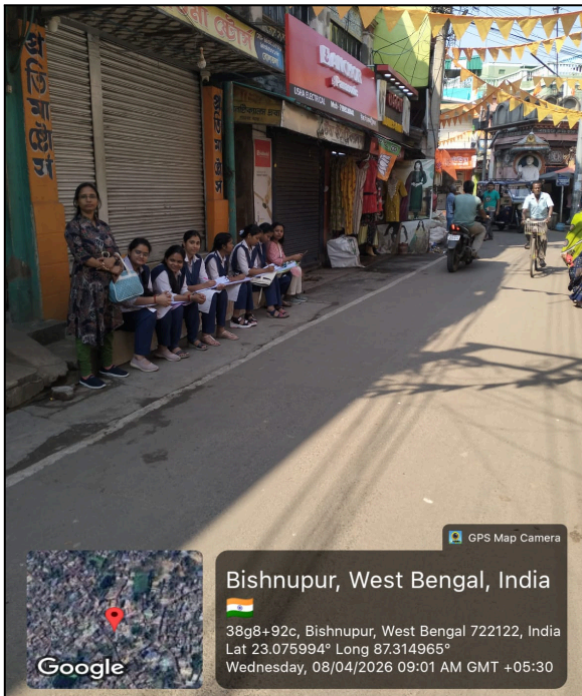
