The Annual prize-giving ceremony, 2026 is being conducted in two phases.

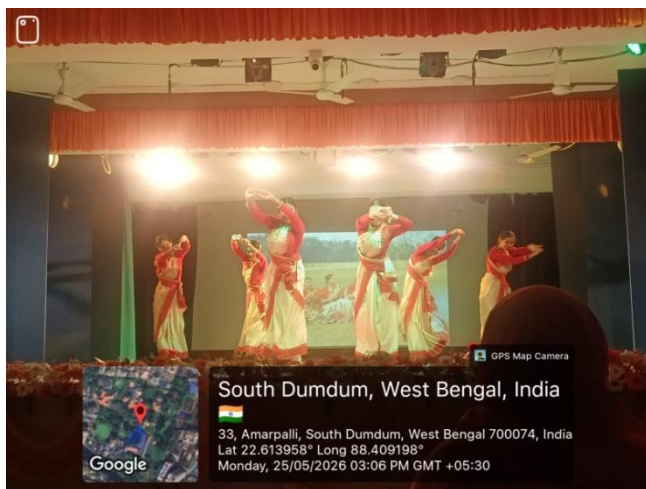
