Brief Description of the Event:

The Department of Bengali & IQAC, RKSMVV celebrated The West Bengal Day on June 20, 2026 in online mode for the students of Semester IV. The topic of the event was “বঙ্গভাষা-সাহিত্য ও বাঙালির অস্তিত্ব”.
