

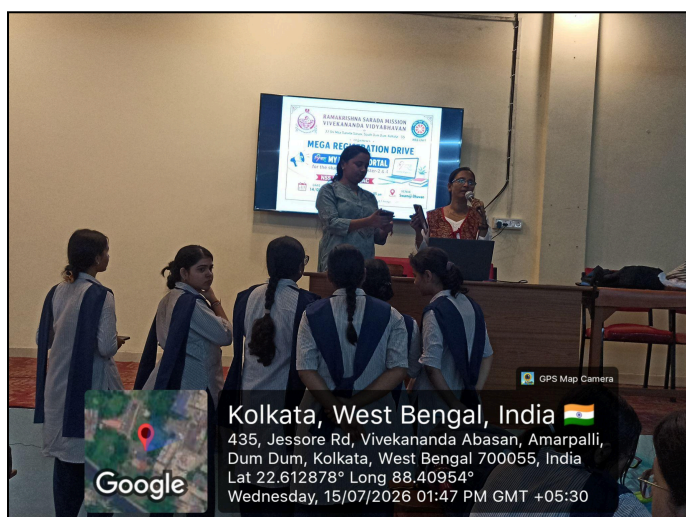
NATIONAL SERVICE SCHEME (NSS), RKSMVV EVENT REPORT

- **Brief description of the event :**

The "Mega Registration Programme in My Bharat Portal" was successfully organized by the NSS Unit in collaboration with the IQAC of Ramakrishna Sarada Mission Vivekananda Vidyabhavan. The Programme started on 14 July 2026 at Swamiji Bhavan from 1:45 p.m. onwards and it took two days to complete successful registration of a total 142 students on the My Bharat Portal.

The programme witnessed enthusiastic participation and helped increase awareness about the opportunities available through the platform, enabling students to actively participate in various social, educational, and developmental initiatives at the local and national levels. During the session, NSS volunteers and faculty members guided the participants through the online registration process, explained the features and benefits of the portal, and assisted them in creating their profiles. The event concluded successfully with students expressing keen interest in engaging in future volunteer activities through the My Bharat platform.
