Brief description of the event: The lecture aimed to sensitise students to the psychological, social, and developmental aspects of sexuality among young people while promoting awareness about gender equality and the importance of challenging rigid gender stereotypes. Ms. Chakraborty discussed the biological, emotional, and social dimensions of sexuality, highlighting how misconceptions, societal expectations, and gender-based prejudices can affect the mental health and overall well-being of adolescents and young adults.

The resource person emphasised the need for inclusive attitudes, mutual respect, empathy, and acceptance of diversity. She encouraged students to critically examine traditional gender roles and to adopt a more equitable and non-discriminatory outlook in their personal and professional lives. Through relatable examples, interactive discussions, and practical illustrations, the session enabled participants to reflect on their own beliefs and attitudes towards gender and sexuality.

Programme Outcome : The lecture witnessed active participation from students and faculty members, who engaged enthusiastically in the question-and-answer session. Participants raised thoughtful queries regarding gender identity, sexual orientation, consent, and the influence of media and culture on gender perceptions. The interactive nature of the programme created a safe and respectful environment for meaningful dialogue on topics that are often considered sensitive. Overall, the extension lecture successfully enhanced awareness, encouraged critical thinking, and reinforced the importance of fostering inclusive and non-stereotypical attitudes among youth for building a more compassionate and equitable society.
