Brief Description of the Event

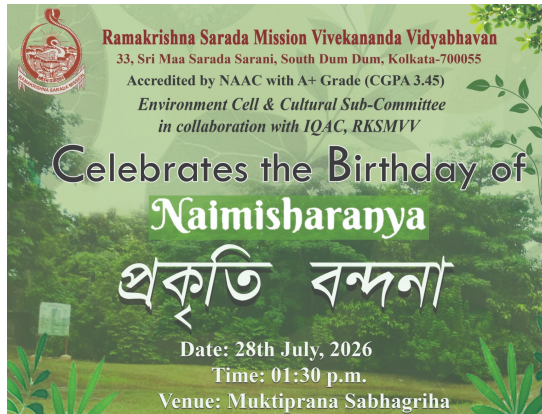

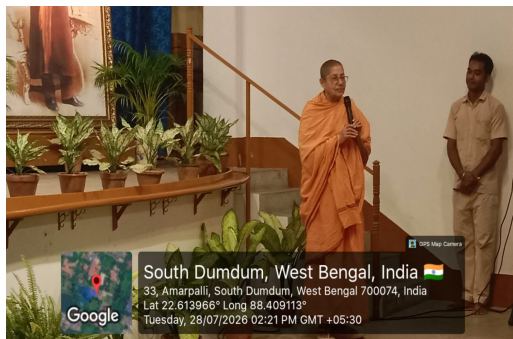
Programme Outcome

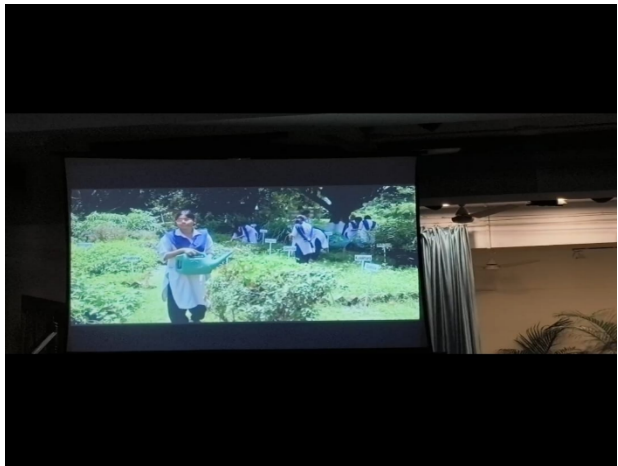
